

DAY CARE SERVICE

We offer day care to support clients who suffer from conditions such as dementia, Parkinson's disease or learning disabilities to help provide their carers with a break. Our staff are trained to help them meet the complex needs of clients and to work in a person centred approach.

Day care can be as frequent or seldom as required - anything from 7 days a week, providing regular and social interaction, to "once in a blue moon" to enable carers to attend to personal needs, or rest and relax.



We provide services such as:

- * Activities - eg. concerts, sing-a-longs arts and crafts, gentle walks outside.
- * Meals - please let us know of dietary requirements.
- * Assisted bathing - especially useful if carers find this a struggle at home.
- * Treatments such as hairdressing or chiropody, as available on the day (This service is at an extra cost).
- * Art and music therapy.
- * Aromatherapy, creating a relaxing atmosphere and sense of well being.



Our Home Manager or a senior member of staff would be happy to welcome you to St Anne's for a visit or to discuss any care needs you may have.

St Anne's Care Home is situated in the picturesque village of Clifton, near Deddington, in rural North Oxfordshire.

This beautifully restored home has a mellow 16th century facade of Hornton Stone, though the property itself has been extensively renovated to offer purpose built accommodation for 22 residents.



The philosophy of care at St Anne's is to treat every resident as we would wish to be treated ourselves; with dignity, respect and love.

We aim to provide a stimulating atmosphere that maintains each resident's physical and mental capabilities for as long as possible. Residents are encouraged to maintain their independence with help and reassurance given as required.

St Anne's is run by the Manager Miss Thereasa Wheeler, who ensures that care is of the highest standards.

Staff are well trained and work as part of a team. We work closely within a multi-disciplinary team to meet the individual needs of the residents.

All staff are encouraged to undertake professional qualifications and the majority of the staff at St Anne's have achieved their NVQ2 or NVQ3.

Residents' needs are thoroughly assessed prior to admission so that staff are already acquainted with their needs.

Upon admission a close relationship is developed, thereby allowing the team to constantly reassess individual care requirements.

Wherever possible, residents or their families are requested to bring a written life history, photographs and memorabilia. This helps staff to understand each individual's personality and background, enabling us to provide the appropriate care. We aim to produce an effective and accurate person centred care plan to meet the unique individual needs of the resident. We encourage residents and their families to contribute to the individual support plan. All plans are updated on a regular basis to help meet the changing needs of the resident.



Residents are encouraged to bring items from home to help personalise their own rooms.

At St Anne's we are able to offer a variety of care services. We can provide long or short term care placements, respite care or day support care services.

We hope that all residents will look at St Anne's as their home.

RESPITE, CONVALESCENCE & HOLIDAY CARE.

We are able to offer a respite care service so that carers can take a well earned break with the knowledge that their loved ones are being cared for in a safe and welcoming environment.

We can take bookings in advance and with availability allowing, provide respite at short notice in an emergency.



St Anne's current respite room is a large and spacious, en-suite bedroom which is relaxing and peaceful.

The room has french doors onto the balcony and over looks part of the home's cottage country garden.



Guests who come for respite care have an individual support plan produced so that their individual needs can be met. Guests are encouraged to join in with activities, if they choose, which are aimed to stimulate and encourage socialising.
